



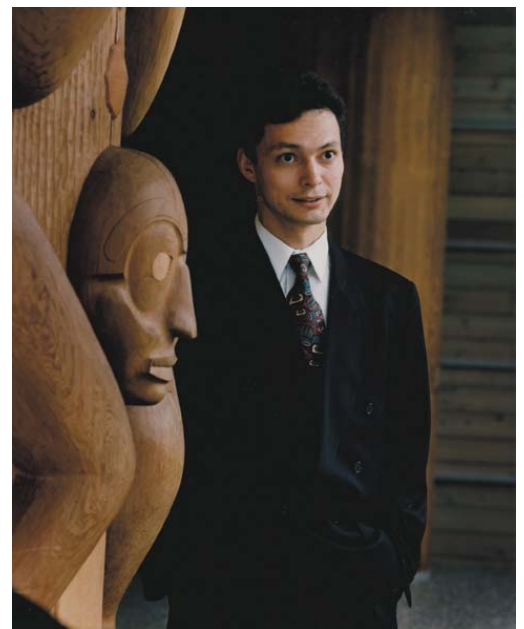

Calvin Helin is one of Canada's best-known indigenous lawyers and hails from a family of ancestral Tsimshian Chiefs (from British Columbia's north coast). With his background, education, and experience, he has transcended cultures, borders, and all expectations with his war on dependency and poverty. Helin received his law degree from the University of British Columbia in 1992. He has been a keynote speaker throughout the United States on topics relating to Native American business and legal issues.

Calvin is an aboriginal rights activist, a lawyer, a martial arts instructor, and best-selling author. Helin also spearheads international multi-million-dollar economic development projects throughout the world. Currently his company owns the rights to one of the hottest high-tech emissions reductions products in the world out of Bakersfield, California (known as Viscon). Helin is active in the creation and direction of many not-for-profit organizations. He is founding President of the Native Investment and Trade Association, founding Vice President of the National Aboriginal Business Association, and a former director of the Vancouver Board of Trade.



He and his family (wife Vernita, daughters Georgina, and Denise, son Lewis, and grandson Lucius) reside in Vancouver, British Columbia.
